AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND DORCHESTER COUNTY ORDINANCE 08-14 TO PROVIDE FOR SIGNS THAT INDICATE TIME, DATE AND TEMPERATURE

Dorchester County duly assembled hereby amends Dorchester County Ordinance 08-14 with respect to that portion thereof providing for signs located within the Transitional Overlay District so that following amendment that portion of 08-14 shall read as follows:


(6) All signs located within the TOD shall comply with the following standards:

Maximum Sign Face Area (square feet) [1]	50
Maximum Sign Height (feet) [2]	10
Maximum number of signs per major road	1
Internal Illumination Allowed. Flashing or moving signs not allowed; save and except signs may indicate by movement, time, date and temperature.	

[1] A maximum of two (2) sign faces shall be allowed per sign.

[2] Freestanding signs shall be monument or pedestal type.


