ORDINANCE NUMBER 08-23

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND DORCHESTER COUNTY ORDINANCE NUMBER 92-15 AS PREVIOUSLY AMENDED BY DORCHESTER COUNTY ORDINANCE NUMBER 94-03, 05-02, 06-20, 07-01 AND 08-07 CONCERNING THE HOME GARAGING OF CERTAIN COUNTY VEHICLES.

WHEREAS, by Dorchester County Ordinance 92-15, Dorchester County Council set forth certain requirements for the safe, efficient and effective use of all County equipment and vehicles; and

WHEREAS, Dorchester County Ordinance Number 92-15 has been subsequently amended by Dorchester County Ordinances 94-03, 05-02, 06-20, 07-01 and 08-07 with respect to Section VI(G) to provide certain exceptions for the requirement that all vehicles be garaged at appropriate County Buildings; and

WHEREAS, Dorchester County Council wishes to further amend Section VI(G) to provide that exceptions to the requirement that all vehicles be garaged at the appropriate County Building be adopted by Resolution rather than setting forth such exceptions by Ordinance.


NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by Dorchester County Council, duly assembled, as follows:

Section VI(G) as set forth in Dorchester County Ordinance Number 92-15 as amended by Dorchester County Ordinances 94-03, 05-02, 06-20, 07-01 and 08-07 is hereby amended so that following this amendment, said Section VI(G) shall read as follows:

“Employees not authorized to take vehicles home at night or over weekends by appropriate Resolution of Dorchester County Council, shall not do so except that when the conduct of the County business can be facilitated, permission may be granted by the County Administrator on a daily basis. All vehicles except those which are allowed to be home garaged pursuant to Resolution of Dorchester County Council, will be garaged at the appropriate County Building. Exceptions to this rule can be made by the County Administrator for emergency or contingency circumstances, such as hurricane, tornado, flooding, etc.

Except as specifically amended hereby, Dorchester County Ordinance 92-15, as amended by Dorchester County Ordinance Number 94-03, 05-02, 06-20, 07-01 and 08-07 shall remain in full force and effect.


