ORDINANCE NUMBER 09-13

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT PUBLIC BOAT LANDINGS


WHEREAS, Dorchester County is empowered to adopt ordinances as may appear to be necessary and proper for the security, general welfare and convenience of the county and for preserving health, peace, order and good government.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Dorchester County Council, duly assembled, as follows:

1. It shall be unlawful for any person to consume any alcoholic liquor, beer, wine or possess any open container of the same at any public boat landing in Dorchester County not licensed for on-premises consumption of alcoholic beverages.
2. Any person found to have violated this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, be fined not more than \$500.00 or imprisoned for not more than 30 days.


This Ordinance shall be effective upon third and final reading.
